Voice Health camp is one such Special initiative to provide health care service to meet the immediate health care needs of the marginalized community in remote rural areas and slum through standalone camps smile organize and customised health camps extensively across the country offering comprehensive health services curative ,preventive and referral to a large number of people in selected interventions areas .

Voice health camps aims at reaching out to at least 80 villages in 10 yrs time and experts to improve the health seeking behaviour among the community .the uniqueness of the model in its comprehensive approach where health promotion and prevention are given equal importance while curative care is administered.
